Breaking News Growing Together in Grace

Grace Lutheran School is pleased to announce that the Growing Together in Grace capital improvement campaign has surpassed the 66% fundraising threshold and the Board of Education has approved the go-ahead on the next steps of Phase 1 of the campaign. Phase 1 is a large construction project replacing classroom doors and windows, efficient heating and air conditioning (!!!!!),

security upgrades, complete remodels of the six southernmost classrooms, and new entrances on the north and south ends of the building.

This is an exciting time in Grace's history and we are humbled and thankful for the outpouring of support for the project. God will continue to work in the halls of Grace for many generations to come as continue to grow and work toward expanding our footprint in the community.
